Rules for Exhibits

Teams are expected to bring their own copies of the exhibits. Counsel who wish to use an exhibit must enter it into evidence in the usual way, by establishing a foundation for the exhibit. Foundation for the exhibit can be established by referencing that the exhibit was previously verified under oath by the Crown prior to the start of the mock trial. The first time an exhibit is entered, the copy that was entered becomes the “real” exhibit, and subsequent counsel will need to ask for the exhibit from the court clerk in order to put it to a witness.

- The Gun - **the gun was found in the possession of the accused.** There is no additional information about where it was found. Any issues about whether the gun was legal or illegal are not the subject of this trial, and either questions about that issue or evidence to show that the gun is an illegal gun are not permitted.
- The Knife - **the knife was found in the possession of the deceased.** There is no additional information about where it was found. The fact that it was found in the possession of the deceased is accepted by all parties and the picture of the knife is admissible. There is no information about the second knife that was allegedly in the possession of Max Luo beyond what is in the witness statements.
- The Pathology report - **the pathology report is accepted for the truth of its contents, and the parties are required to agree that the pathologist does not need to be called as a witness to prove the report.**
- **The CV is the doctor’s CV.** It is not open to challenge.
- The map - **the map is a true and accurate representation of the neighbourhood.** Who lives where must be the subject of evidence from a witness (or witnesses) who has (or have) the knowledge to provide the information set out on the map.

CORONER'S/PATHOLOGIST'S REPORT

Date: July 25, 2023

Name of Deceased: Bailey Tanner

The deceased was a 34 year-old, 172 cm in height and weighing 175 pounds. A full autopsy with respect to the organs of the deceased was performed (omitted from this report).

The deceased had a blood alcohol level of .08, the level which is deemed unlawful for the operation of an automobile. The level of alcohol does not reveal impairment necessarily nor could it be determined when the deceased last consumed alcohol.

The examination of the body revealed one gunshot wound. The gunshot wound was located on the head of the deceased with entry in the forehead. Death would have occurred within minutes of this injury.

The cause of death was a gunshot wound to the head.
