The FLYP project is currently in its pilot stage. [OJEN/ROEJ](#) is partnering with four organizations in Toronto that provide support services to new and expecting young mothers. Through experiential learning and connecting with justice sector volunteers, participants familiarize themselves with the laws and processes that they might face in their lives. At the same time they are given opportunities to develop advocacy, public speaking, interpersonal, and reasoning skills and become more legally capable. With 50 organizations in the GTA alone, and hundreds province-wide offering services to young parents, there is enormous possibilities to reach many more vulnerable young parents, and \$10,000 would go a long way to make it happen.
