



The Hux-Kiteley Exemplary Justice Educator Award

This award recognizes an educator in the province of Ontario who has demonstrated exceptional leadership in the area of justice education. It was named after two of the members of OJEN's original Board of Directors; Allan Hux, who represented Ontario History and Social Science Teachers' Association and Justice Fran Kiteley, who was the Superior Court of Justice representative as well as OJEN's first Chair. This annual award was established by the OJEN Board of Directors in honour of the foundational role both played in establishing OJEN.

Awarded annually to an educator in Ontario, the criteria could include any combination of:

- Innovation in justice education
- Collaborative approaches to teaching about legal issues
- Promotion of democratic participation
- Leadership among peers in promoting justice education
